Compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs) when compared with standard incandescent bulbs, offer many benefits. First, they help save energy and money. They use 2/3 less energy than standard incandescent light bulbs, and last up to 10 times longer. Replacing a 60-watt incandescent with a 13-watt CFL can save you at least \$30 in energy costs over the life of the bulb.

CFLs do however; contain trace amounts of mercury (less than your average household thermometer). At the end of their life, CFLs should be disposed of properly. **Do not throw your CFLs away with the household garbage.** This increases the chance for breakage and potential contamination. Use the RecyclePak recycling kit, for simple, inexpensive recycling for all of your CFLs
